PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

The Parish Council Elections on 3rd May were uncontested as 5 candidates stood for 7 places. Subsequently two new Councillors have been co-opted onto the Parish Council. Your Parish Councillors are now:

The traffic Speed Indicator Device (SID) that was stationed in the Village earlier in the year only gave 4 reliable days of data due to technical problems, so it has been re-deployed. The data that it did collect showed high traffic speeds – they use an '85 percentile' measure which was as high as 41mph in the 30mph speed limit. 
